















Massing and Program Summary

Aerial View from NE





- Typical floor plate size can range from 20,000 sf to 28,000 sf depending on programmatic needs



Parcel 42 has access to the city and the region by foot, bike, micromobility devices, bus, train, and car.

Downtown Transit Connector (DTC) Stop

150 ft / 1 min walk DTC Frequency: approximately every 5 minutes during peak times


